SECTION 17 TO 20 AND 135 SALE AND SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL ACT 2012

031/OFF/005/2023

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Skyview Enterprises Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 21 High Street, Waipawa and known as "Super Liquor Waipawa", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. If this licence is not endorsed under Section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF OFF-LICENCE

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold while the premises are operating as a bottle store, but only on the following days an during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 9am to 10pm

(c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.

(e) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.

- (f) Appropriate signage regarding the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be prominently displayed adjacent to every point of sale.
- (g) Only the area delineated on the plan is a permitted area for the display and promotion of alcohol. A copy of the plan must be either displayed alongside this licence, or available for viewing at the premises upon request.
- (h) Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as a supervised area: Entire premises

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in or from the whole of the premises. The premises, situated at 21 High Street, Waipawa, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan received by the Central Hawke's Bay District Licensing Committee.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the car park is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force:

- (a) Either:
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either:
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
